Minutes of the Committee Meeting January 10, 2023 – Hybrid Meeting Hosted by Miss Utility Call Center – Hanover Prepared by Secretary, Susan Sullivan

WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS OF ATTENDEES

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Scott Brown at 10:14 am. Customary attendee introductions were made.

MD/DC Guidebook Committee Reported by Susan Sullivan (Miss Utility)

A draft copy of the Maryland Damage Prevention Guide to be sent out by Monday, January 16th to all Board Members for review and input. The first round of edits will be due to Susan approximately ten (10) days later with a reminder to have all final edits in by February 3rd.

Dig Smart Awards Program Criteria

Follow-up discussion focused on the importance of this vetting process and the feedback that must come from facility owner members and contract locators as to contractor/excavator activity, behavior, and safe digging practices in the field. PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS

MGH 2023 Campaign and Budget Overview

Chris McMurry (MGH) gave a brief overview of 2023 Campaign highlights along with the 2023 proposed budget. A \$30,000 budget reduction was noted. A decrease in the number of sponsored vehicles per the Carvertise campaign and a slight reduction in material production was proposed as a means of absorbing most of the proposed reduction. Additionally, in lieu of Frederick Keys and Aberdeen IronBirds sponsorships, for the second year in a row, it was suggested that a Touch A Truck type event be considered for outreach in the Fredrick area for 2024. A motion to approve the 2023 budget as written was made by David Wilkins (WCCS) and seconded by Angela Johnson (AT&T). The motion carried by approval.

Carvertise Reported by Susan Sullivan, Miss Utility

- Nine wrapped cars currently travel throughout 8 Maryland counties, Baltimore City and Washington D.C.
- The approved 2023 budget may require a reduction in the number of cars currently contracted by Carvertise. Any reduction will be based on current damage reporting.

CALL CENTER REPORTS

Updates Reported by Jennifer Arroyo, Miss Utility

Jennifer shared information on iVerify, software created by OCC to analyze the accuracy of every ticket's scope of work in relation to its created polygon. When this information is determined to be inaccurate, an alert is created, and the ticket is reviewed by a call center supervisor. If an inaccuracy is confirmed, an attempt to contact the user is made and when possible, the ticket corrected with user approval. If inaccuracies remain on-going with a direct release user, the user may lose direct release privileges and put back into review. These procedures are intended to increase ticket accuracy and thereby, excavation safety.

Jennifer also stated that testing related to D.C. ticketing changes should begin by end of month. She also confirmed that notification will go out communicating and confirming all ticketing, law changes and updates via a broadcast email notification.
